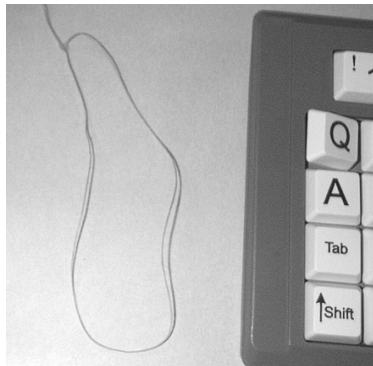


How to change the alpha keys on a BigKeys keyboard

STEP 1: Use a piece of strong string to pop off the alpha keys:

Use about 20 inches of string (dental floss works), tied in a loop.



Slip the loop under and at the center of the keycap, and pull straight up with a quick, strong snap. Repeat for the remaining 25 alpha keys.

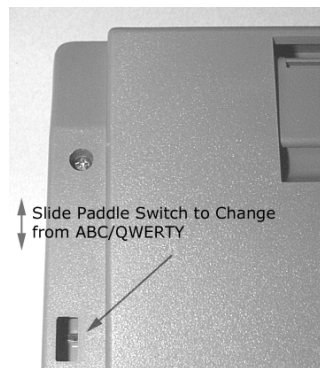


STEP 2: Replace the keys by snapping them in place.

STEP 3: Key order switch:

PS/2 ONLY

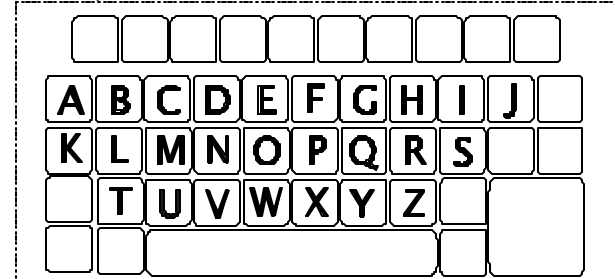
If you have changed the order of the keys. To switch between layouts, the switch on the left, in the bottom of the keyboard, should be moved, with a pencil tip, toward the lower edge of the keyboard for ABC or towards the upper edge for QWERTY.



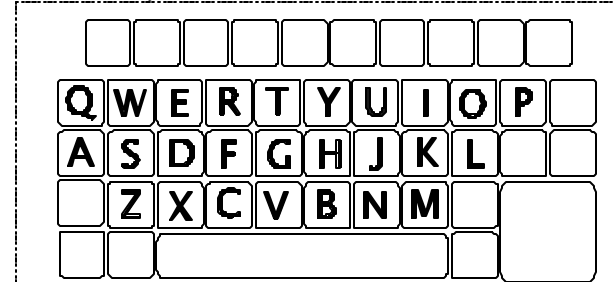
LX ABC - QWERTY OPTION

Your BigKeys LX keyboard offers either ABC or QWERTY layouts.

ABC Layout



QWERTY Layout



Although the letters on the keycaps will remain the same, the computer will interpret all keystrokes as coming from the alternate keyboard layout.

See Step 3 for PS/2 or ABCto change from USB to QWERTY

STEP 3:

USB ONLY

Be sure the computer is powered on and that the BigKeys is unplugged.

Hold down the numeric key for the option desired.

While holding down the key, plug the keyboard into a USB port on the computer.

Release the key after 5 seconds, the option will now be in place.

QWERTY Mode use numeric key 1

ABC Mode use numeric key 2
